O Serviço do Ensino Superior (SES), torna público que o Ministério da Agricultura da Hungria abriu as inscrições para o programa de bolsas "AM-FAO" para o ano académico de 2022/23.

O Curso é ministrado em inglês na universidade Húngara de Agricultura e Ciências da Vida na Buda Campus, Budapeste

Condições:

Os cursos serão oferecidos desde que o número mínimo de alunos seja atingido.

A bolsa cobrirá:

- propinas durante todo o período de estudo com livros e notas básicas;
- alojamento em dormitório;
- custos de subsistência;
- plano de saúde.

Todos os custos acima mencionados são financiados pelo governo húngaro, de acordo com o Acordo entre a FAO e a Hungria em 2007.

A bolsa cobre apenas os custos do estudante; os membros da família não são apoiados no âmbito deste programa.

Procedimento de aplicação

Os candidatos interessados devem preparar um dossiê a ser enviado por E-MAIL composto por:

- Formulário de inscrição devidamente preenchido
- Um currículo recente
- Uma cópia do diploma do ensino médio/faculdade e histórico escolar/relatório de estudo ou cópia do anexo do diploma
- Uma cópia do certificado de proficiência em inglês

Todos os documentos enviados devem estar em INGLÊS. Não serão aceites documentos enviados em qualquer outro idioma. É de responsabilidade do solicitante garantir que os documentos sejam devidamente traduzidos e autenticados por órgão competente; e que cada documento seja salvo com um nome que identifique o que é.

Processo de candidatura e seleção

O processo de seleção, conforme descrito abaixo, se aplica a bolsas de estudo com início em setembro de 2022.

A seleção dos alunos ocorrerá em duas fases:

Fase 1: A FAO fará uma pré-seleção dos candidatos e enviará as inscrições ao Ministério da Agricultura da Hungria, que as enviará à Universidade. Os alunos devem apresentar apenas dossiês COMPLETOS. Dossiês incompletos não serão considerados. Arquivos sem nomes não serão processados.

Fase 2: Os candidatos selecionados podem ser solicitados a fazer um exame de inglês escrito ou oral como parte do procedimento de admissão. A Universidade realizará um novo processo de seleção e informará cada um dos candidatos aprovados. A seleção dos alunos será feita apenas pela Universidade, sem qualquer envolvimento por parte da FAO. Os alunos selecionados também serão notificados pelo Ministério.

Os candidatos serão selecionados com base nos seguintes critérios:

- Cidadania e residência de um dos países elegíveis
- Excelentes resultados escolares
- Proficiência em inglês (para cursos ministrados em inglês)
- Motivação
- Boa saúde
- Idade (candidatos com menos de 30 anos são preferidos)

DESCRIPTION OF Hungarian Government Scholarship PROGRAMME AND E-MAIL APPLICATION PROCEDURES

The following Master of Science degree course is being offered in English for the 2022-23 Academic Year:

1. Master in Food Safety and Quality Engineering

University: Hungarian University of Agriculture and Life Sciences

Campus: Buda Campus, Budapest

Conditions

Courses will be offered provided the minimum number of students is reached.

The scholarship will cover:

- application and tuition fees throughout the study period with basic books and notes;
- dormitory accommodation;
- subsistence costs;
- health insurance.

All of the above mentioned costs are financed by the Hungarian Government, according to the Agreement between FAO and Hungary in 2007.

The scholarship covers student costs only; family members are not supported within the frame of this programme.

List of Eligible countries

Residents (who must be nationals) of the following countries are eligible to apply for the

Scholarship Programme:

Afghanistan, Albania, Algeria, Angola, Azerbaijan, Armenia, Bangladesh, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Burkina Faso, Cambodia, Chad, Egypt, Ethiopia, Gambia, Georgia, Ghana, Jordan, Kazakhstan, Kenya, Kosovo¹, Kyrgyzstan, Laos, Lebanon, North Macedonia, Madagascar, Mali, Myanmar, Republic of Moldova, Mongolia, Montenegro, Namibia, Nigeria, North Korea, State of Palestine, the Philippines, Republic of Cabo Verde, Serbia, Somalia, South Sudan, Sudan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Uganda, Ukraine, Uzbekistan, Vietnam, Yemen.

¹References to Kosovo shall be understood to be in the context of Security Council Resolution 1244 (1999).

Application procedure

Interested applicants should prepare a dossier to be sent by E-MAIL consisting of:

- Application form duly completed
- A recent curriculum vitae
- A copy of high school/college diploma and transcript/report of study or copy of the diploma attachment
- A copy of certificate of proficiency in English
- Copies of relevant pages of passport showing expiration date and passport number
- A letter of recommendation
- Statement of motivation

- Health Certificate issued by Medical Doctor
- Certificate of Good Conduct issued by local police authority.

All submitted documents must be in ENGLISH. Documents submitted in any other language will not be accepted. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that documents are duly translated and certified by a competent office; and that each document is saved with a name that identifies what it is.

Application and selection process

The selection process as described below applies to scholarships beginning in September 2022.

Student selection will take place in two phases:

Phase 1: FAO will pre-screen candidates and submit applications to the Ministry of Agriculture of Hungary that will send them to the University. Students must submit only COMPLETE dossiers. **Incomplete dossiers will not be considered**. Files without names will not be processed.

Phase 2: Selected candidates may be asked to take a written or oral English examination as part of the admission procedure. The University will run a further selection process and inform each of the successful candidates. Student selection will be made by the University only, without any involvement on the part of FAO. Selected students will also be notified by the Ministry.

Candidates will be selected on the basis of the following criteria:

- Citizenship and residency of one of the eligible countries
- Excellent school achievements
- English language proficiency (for courses taught in English)
- Motivation
- Good health
- Age (candidates under 30 are preferred)

Deadlines

Applications by applicants should be E-MAILED to FAO between

15 January 2022 and 28 February 2022

Paper copies of dossiers received by post or courier or any other way, will not be taken into consideration.

Important notes

Please follow the information about Hungarian entry requirements during the Covid-19 pandemic preparedness period. Subject to final approval, the organisers reserve the right to make changes to the scholarship. The rules related to the pandemic must be strictly followed any times.

Applicants who were not selected in previous years may re-apply to the 2022-2023 Programme. These applicants will have to submit the complete dossier once again by E-MAIL ONLY.

Please note that the duration of the scholarship cannot be extended or postponed.

Please be informed that the course will only start if sufficient number of successful applications will be received.

A Scholarship Study Contract will be signed between the selected students and the Ministry of Agriculture of Hungary (MoAH), which is the donor of the program, at the time of first semester registration.

Applicants wishing to explore external funding opportunities to cover the travel costs may do so at their own initiative. However, in view of the length of the process, applicants wishing to apply for 2022 scholarships are strongly encouraged to E-MAIL their application while they endeavour to identify funds or pending confirmation that such funds will be granted.

Course name: Master in Food Safety and Quality Engineering

Degree: Master in Food Safety and Quality Engineer

Education goals

The aim of the training is the education of food safety and quality engineers obtaining a master degree, who can apply their microbiological, molecular biological, toxicological and analytical chemical knowledge to control and check the production and distribution of food that has high quality and is appropriate by all means for human nutrition. Capability for individual work, professional opinion creation and decision making, capability for research, development and management, leadership management, creativity, efficient problem solving and capability for applying and analyzing information is required.

Length of the study programme: 4 semesters (22 months)

Total credit: 120 Admission criteria

Bachelor degree certificate in related field and transcript of records about previous studies (at least 60 credits parity with our Institution's Food Engineering BSc programme)

Language requirements:

For the admission, the minimum is a complex (combination of oral and written) C1 level accredited English language exam.

Procedure for transfer of credits

Requests for transfer of credits will be considered individually based on the BSc degree and course transcript.

Requirements: 1) credit accomplished not later than 5 years ago 2) the content of the completed subject is at least 75% equivalent to the subject to accept 3) credit values are the same 4) subject to accept was completed in English
